Free Training

Healthwatch's from across North, Central and East London are currently recruiting people to join its Enter & View project

What is Enter and View?

The Enter and View programme is an important part of the way Healthwatch's work. Volunteer Representatives can visit and report on premises where health and social care services are being used by residents such as hospitals, GP Practices and care homes for example.

The People We Need

This project has been commissioned to enable us to understand and reduce the barriers to inclusion. We are currently recruiting people with communication impairments such as:

- People who are Deaf or hard of hearing
- People with sensory impairments
- People who have acquired a brain injury
- People who have had a stroke
- Carers of people with communication impairments

By involving people with communication impairments who currently use health and social care services we hope to ensure greater feedback to the NHS and Local Authorities and take note of what is happening in places where problems have been reported, or where examples of interesting or good practice can be made known and publicised.

Training

Accessible support will be provided (BSL, loop, easy read, large print etc). Training dates and venues can be found overleaf.

Visits

Enter and View visits will take place in January and representatives will need to be able to commit to at least <u>one</u> visit date and further session. Visit dates will be confirmed at the training sessions.
