What Is Mystery Shopping?

It is a tool used to measure quality of service, compliance with regulation, or to gather specific information about services. It is a snap shot research technique.

The People We Need

This project has been commissioned to enable us to understand and reduce barriers to inclusion. We are currently recruiting people with communication impairments that impact on their ability to access NHS services. These are:

- People who are Deaf or hard of hearing
- People with sensory impairments
- People who have acquired a brain injury
- People who have had a stroke
